- Up to \$5,000 for short-term (1 year) projects
- Rolling application first-come, first-serve awards
- Promote source reduction, reuse, or repair in Massachusetts
- An organization or business (for-profit or non-profit) that is properly licensed to operate in Massachusetts is eligible

### **Source Reduction Strategies**

- Explore/leverage initiatives to reduce packaging waste
- Promote "sharing economy" strategies
- Implement residential source reduction linked to PAYT
- Foster "right to repair" information sharing
- Develop commercial food waste source reduction initiative
- Leverage procurement to reduce commercial & institutional waste
- Renew emphasis on resource management contracting
- Bans on single use plastic bags and food service packaging
