MassDEP Receives EPA Food Recovery Challenge Endorser Award

The <u>Massachusetts Department of Environmental</u> <u>Protection</u> (MassDEP) won the <u>EPA's 2015 National Food</u> <u>Recovery Challenge Endorser Award</u> for leading food recovery outreach and technical assistance efforts in the Commonwealth, and for its direction of the <u>RecyclingWorks</u> <u>in MA</u> program administered by the <u>Center for</u> <u>EcoTechnology</u>.

In the past 12 months, during which the State of Massachusetts launched its <u>Commercial Organics Waste</u> <u>Ban</u>, RecyclingWorks has helped businesses improve food waste diversion programs, including food donation, animal feed, anaerobic digestion and composting. These programs have helped divert more than 4,570 tons of food waste from the trash on an annual basis.
