#### **Deconstruction and Reclamation of Building Materials**

Deconstruction involves carefully dismantling a building in order to reclaim useable cabinets, fixtures, doors, windows, flooring and other building materials. Donating building materials can provide many benefits including saving money on disposal costs and qualifying for a tax deduction when those materials are donated to a non-profit 501 (c)3 organization. Using reclaimed building materials in new construction or renovations can save money on material costs. Unique or vintage materials can help meet project needs or designs that are difficult to achieve using new materials.
