2030 Solid Waste Master Plan

- Completed comment period on Draft Plan in December
- Final Plan and Response to Comments going through review now
- Has been delayed due to COVID 19, but hope to finalize soon

Proposed Waste Ban Additions

- Mattresses
- Textiles
- Reducing food waste ban threshold from 1 ton to ½ ton per week
- Developing draft regulations now
- Will be supported by comprehensive Action Plan strategies
- Goal is to finalize in fall 2020
- Proposed effective date of fall 2021
